ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING 2023 AT KOCHI

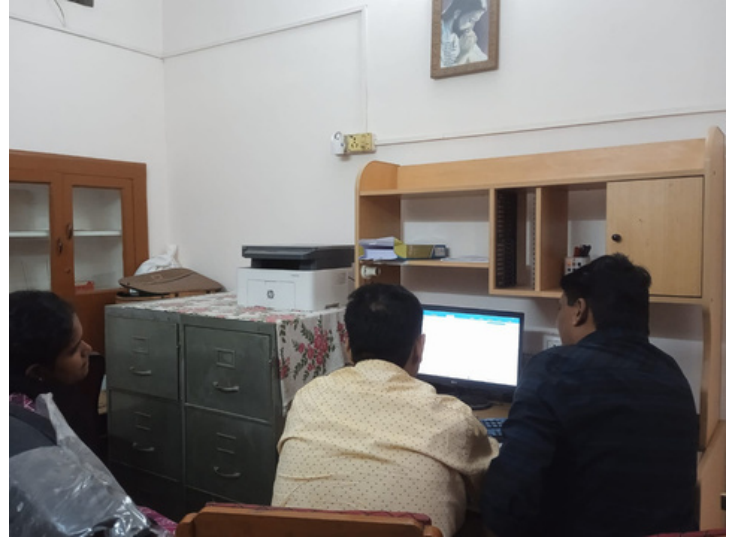
