attended by 26 participants.


The Workshop set out to explore the different teaching methods with emphasis on Bloom's




Fr. Leslie Moras, President, Xavier Board welcomed with flowers

Dr. Ms. Ordetta Mendoza inspired the audience by making them aware of being better human beings and successful mentors.


Talking from her experience, Dr. Mendoza also spoke about the difficult situations faced by students and the role of teachers as mentors in their lives.




Dr. Ms. Kavitha introduced the faculty to web based LMS using Moodle and helped them by taking them through an hour of practical session.
