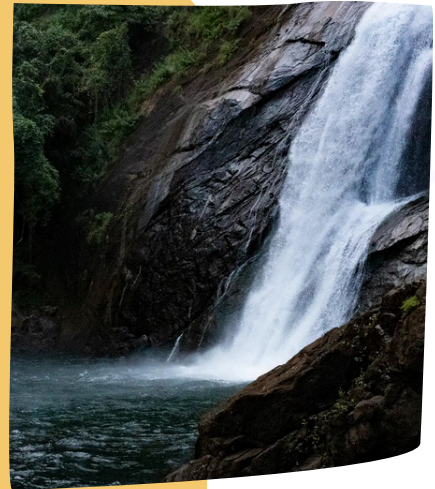
### Malankara Dam

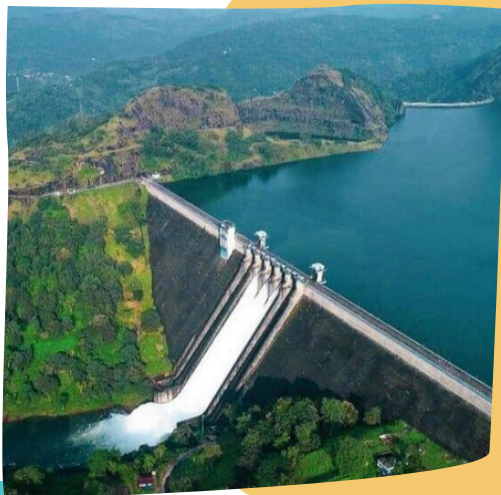

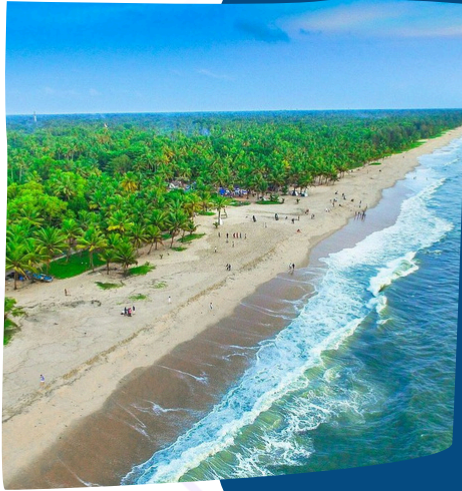
